

- (a) To commemorate an event of historical significance to the Town;
 - (b) Recognize volunteers, service efforts, and retiring Town officers; and
 - (c) To host or support community celebrations.
2. The Town Board is authorized to determine the appropriateness of the specific expenditures made under this authorization. The Town Board is further authorized to decide which events qualify as a community celebration, but the electors specifically support the following as constituting community celebrations on which funds may be expended:
- (a) Fireworks for Independence Day and New Year's celebrations;
 - (b) Corn Feed Harvest Celebration;
 - (c) Kids Holiday Celebration;
 - (d) Ice Fishing Contest;
 - (e) Oktoberfest;
 - (f) Summer Fishing Contest; and
 - (g) Annual Town Fire Department Dance.
3. The authorization provided by this Resolution is on-going and the Town Board is not required to seek further elector authorization for this purpose unless it proposes to spend more in a year than is indicated above.
4. The prior expenditures made by the Town Board for any of the purposes authorized by this Resolution are hereby approved and ratified.


