PUBLIC ROAD VACATION HEARING APRIL 14, 2016

The Public Hearing for the Road Vacation Petition regarding the vacation of all of North Street, all of South Street and all of West Street as dedicated in the PLAT OF ROOSEVELT SOO was called to order at the location of 625 State 6 at 6:30 PM by Chairman Thyen.

Mr. Porter, Attorney for the Petitioners, was present to explain the petition. The petition is to vacate roads in the PLAT OF ROOSEVELT SOO known as North Street, South Street and West Street. It is not to vacate any current roads in existence. His office served all people necessary.
