CROOKED LAKE TOWNSHIP—MONTHLY MTG.—Sept. 12, 2013

The Meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Members present: Connie Glass, Mark Skjolsvik, Dave Schaumburg, Lloyd Thyen, Pat Faul, Glen Mechelke. Absent, Rod Schloesser.

MOTION: Skjolsvik, 2<sup>nd</sup> Glass to approve the August 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting minutes. Motion carried.

The Treasurer's report showed a checkbook balance of \$88,725.87.

Darril Wegscheid discussed the "burn-off" of aqua scape near the Outing dock. This involved the burning of dead grass between the bridge and the Outing dock on Roosevelt Lake. The Supervisors were supportive of this project, as it had been done in the past.

Discussed Fehrs road project. A contractor is being looked for to work on Fehrs road project.

Not much additional information has been available on the pipeline project.

Discussed Peninsula Road.

Discussed Luschers Park playground equipment.

Larry Zdemek has a contract to plow Beulah Township roads. He questioned if the Crooked Lake Township board would be interested in having him plow the portion of West Leavitt Lake Road owned by Crooked Lake Township as he was plowing the portion owned by Beulah Township.

MOTION: Thyen, 2<sup>nd</sup> Skjolsvik to table the decision on the plowing of West Leavitt Lake Road to the next monthly mtg. Motion carried

Discussed Crooked Lake Township's aggregate hauling contract with Swenson Aggregate & Construction LL.C.

MOTION, Thyen, 2<sup>nd</sup> Schaumburg to rescind the motion from the August 22 meeting regarding removing trees from County administered land and Township land on Fehrs Road a width of 15 feet on each side of the roadbed, and to withdraw the request sent to the County Land Dept. on August 12. Rather than clear out the acreage involved, selective cutting will be accomplished to remove potential road hazards or improve the roadway. Motion carried.

Discussed Emergency Preparedness

Dave Schaumburg was very concerned that at our last windstorm Crooked Lake Township had lost power to both the Maintenance Bldg. and the Fire Hall and that made it very difficult to open garage doors if we had needed equipment for an emergency.

Discussed the need for emergency generators.

Discussed the Town Hall addition.

Discussed A.I.S. program and additional wording needed at the Annual Mtg. when approving Crooked Lake Township's participation in the program.

Discussed RaLaLa donations in A.I.S. program.

Dave Schaumburg wanted to go on record stating his great appreciation for the job A.I.S. was doing. He started naming names and then stated he didn't want to miss anyone and then thanked all of the great people involved in making A.I.S. program a complete success.

Board members will meet at 6:45 A.M. at the Town Hall to attend the Fall Conference Mtg. in Hackensack being held Oct. 3, 2013.

Rod Schloesser reported water problem on Longwood Point lower loop that still needs attention. He also felt we should consider purchasing a new brush cutter.

MOTION, Schaumburg, 2<sup>nd</sup> Glass to purchase a new weed whip with conversion kit not to exceed \$500. Motion carried.

Schaumburg stated that building and grounds report is complete.

Discussed nuisance beavers.

Mail balloting is available for all Towns outside the seven County Metro area regardless of population or number of registered voters (County approval is still required).

A letter from Mnsure was passed out to all Supervisors in regard to informing their employees about existence of market places such as MNSure to employees.

A complaint on Plummers Point Road was received from residents at the Town Board Mtg.

MOTION, made and 2<sup>nd</sup> to pay warrants 15344 to 15391. Motion carried.

MOTION, made and 2<sup>nd</sup> to adjourn. Motion carried.
